The project will amend the County's Zoning Ordinance and Code of Regulatory Ordinances to help divert organic materials (such as food, plant, and agricultural materials) from landfills. These changes will help facilitate community garden, residential, agricultural, and commercial based composting operations. The Project proposes 1) the creation of a standalone ordinance, Section 6977 Organic Materials Processing, 2) changes to Section 6902 Animal Waste Processing, which includes changing the section title to Large Commercial Organic Processing, and 3) minor updates and cross references to the existing Zoning Ordinance, Use & Enclosure matrix, and Code of Regulatory Ordinances to ensure that organic materials processing is incorporated throughout the ordinance where necessary.
