As authorized by the City of Santa Clara as a Lead Agency, the City hereby provides a **30-day public review period** for a Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) prepared pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).

Request: **General Plan Amendment from Community Commercial to High Density Residential, Rezone from General Office (OG) to Planned Development (PD) and Architectural Review** of a 100 percent affordable, five-story, 108-unit multifamily residential development with on-site resident amenities, 82 surface and garage parking spaces, landscaping and associated on- and off-site improvements.

## INITIAL STUDY DETERMINATION

An Initial Study was completed by David J. Powers & Associates, Inc., in accordance with CEQA, and is available for review on the City's website at [www.santaclaraca.gov/CEQA](http://www.santaclaraca.gov/CEQA), and at the Central Park Library at 2635 Homestead Road. Based upon the Initial Study, insofar as the project involves a General Plan Amendment, Rezone and Architectural Review to allow the proposed development, ***the project will not have a significant effect on the environment*** because mitigation measures have been incorporated into/added to the project by conditions of approval that will reduce potential impacts to a less-than-significant level.
