


Notice of Intent to Adopt a Negative Declaration

(Study Results Available)

and Opportunity for a Public Hearing

Do you want a public hearing on changes proposed for State Route 41 in Kings County?



PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

Comments will be accepted from June 10, 2022 to July 11, 2022. If there are no major comments or requests for a public hearing, Caltrans will proceed with the project's design.

WHAT'S BEING PLANNED?

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) proposes to resurface, restore, and rehabilitate the roadway on State Route 41 near Reef City in Kings County, from the Kern County line to 0.8 mile west of the Interstate 5/State Route 41 separation. Culverts at 13 locations would be replaced or rehabilitated.

WHY THIS PUBLIC NOTICE? Caltrans has studied the effects this project may have on the environment. Our studies show the project will not significantly affect the quality of the environment. The report that explains why is called an Initial Study with Proposed

Negative Declaration. This notice is to inform you of the preparation of the Initial Study with Proposed Negative Declaration and of its availability for you to read and comment on. This notice also offers you an opportunity to request a public hearing.
