Project Title: Permit No. 12319-2: Murphy Existing Residential Encroachments

Project Applicant (if any): Donald Murphy

Project Location/Address/City/County: The project is located at 7250 Pocket Road on the Sacramento River East Levee, in the City of Sacramento. Section 5, T7N, R4E, MDB&M. Levee Mile 5.26 at 38.49234°N, 121.55424°W, Maintenance Area 9, Sacramento County.

Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project: This is a "name change" permit that includes conditions that are consistent with current flood control standards and policies of the Central Valley Flood Protection Board. This permit supersedes Permit No. 12319 GM (Revised) that was issued to Janet A. Gordon on May 24, 1995. This permit authorizes a gated chain-link fence, a shed, two (2) oak trees, and two (2) fig trees along the landward toe of the left bank levee of the Sacramento River. This name change permit will not authorize the ivy ground cover, three (3) sycamore trees, and timber steps on the landward slope, and five (5) ornamental trees on the landward toe of the Sacramento River since these previously permitted encroachments no longer exist.

Reasons Why Project is Exempt:

Board staff has determined that the project is exempt from CEQA under the Class 1, Existing Facilities categorical exemption (CEQA Guidelines § 15301), because the activity consists of permitting existing private facilities. No expansion of existing or former use will occur. Further, none of the exceptions to the exemption in CEQA Guidelines § 15300.2 apply.

Board staff has determined that an application to change the name of the permittee does not have the potential to result in either a direct physical change in the environment or a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment, and thus, is not a "project" for purposes of the California Environmental Quality Act (Public Resources Code § 21065; CEQA Guidelines § 15378(a)).
