The proposed project would be located within a portion of the R-1/R-2 Reservoir Site. The entire project site is located on an approximately 2.9-acre parcel (Assessor Parcel Number 616-012-02), which is located at the northwest corner of El Toro Road and Moulton Parkway.	
General Project Location (City and/or County): City of Laguna Woods, Orange County	
Project Description: ETWD is proposing to construct a pump station and associated piping (proposed project) within its existing R-1/R-2 Reservoir Site within the City of Laguna Woods (Figure 2, Site Plan). The purpose of the project is	

to introduce a new source of water supply in the western portion of the El Toro Water District service area; this supply would offset the existing volume introduced in the northeastern side of El Toro Water District's service area and would not result in an increase in ETWD's capacity.


