Project Location: The project is located on an unnamed tributary to Steephollow Creek, in the County of Nevada, State of California; Section 29, Township 16N, Range 10E, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) 7.5-minute quad map Chicago Park, MDB&M.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number NEV-24265-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Jestina Jones-Cathcart.

The project consists of the replacement of an existing culvert on an unnamed tributary to Steephollow Creek. The existing crossing consists of two 6" and one 14" steel culverts. The new stream crossing will be constructed with one 48" corrugated metal pipe culvert.
