

7. **DESCRIPTION:** The project consists of gathering information (i.e. geotechnical investigation) to design a crossing at Flood Structure #4 across Calavera Creek within Oak Riparian Park.

ADMINISTRATIVE DETERMINATION: Planning Division staff has completed a preliminary review of this project in accordance with the City of Oceanside's Environmental Review Guidelines and the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), 1970. Based on that review, the Planning Division finds that the proposed project constitutes basic data collection which will not result in a serious or major disturbance to an environmental resource. Therefore, the Planning Division has determined that further environmental evaluation is not required because:

- "The activity is covered by the general rule that CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. Where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment, the activity is not subject to CEQA" (Section 15061(b)(3)); or,
- The project is statutorily exempt, Section _____, (Sections 15260-15277), or,
- The project is categorically exempt, Class 6, "Information Collection" (Section 15306), or,
- The project does not constitute a "project" as defined by CEQA (Section 15378).
