Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:
State Route 269 is a heavily used roadway and over time the pavement within the project limits has deteriorated. The purpose of this project is to repair and replace the existing pavement. The project is needed to address the deteriorated pavement conditions located on State Route 269. This project proposes to cold plane 0.25 foot of the existing asphalt concrete pavement and replace it with 0.25 to 0.40 foot of Hot Mix Asphalt (Type A). In addition, Fog Seal will be applied to the existing Asphalt Concrete Shoulders to extend pavement surface life. This project will not require the acquisition of new right-of-way.
