Allow the creation of four (4) parcels, three 5.01-acre parcels and one 5.03-acre parcel from an existing 23-acre parcel in the located in the RR - 5 (Rural Residential, 5-acre minimum lot size) Zone District.

The subject property is located on the east side of Millerton Lake, west of Sky Harbor Road, approximately 4.75 miles northeast of the nearest city limits of the City of Clovis .

It has been determined that there would be no impacts or a less than significant impact to Aesthetics, Agricultural and Forestry Resources, Air Quality, Biological Resources, Energy, Geology and Soils, Greenhouse Gas Emissions, Hazards and Hazardous Materials, Hydrology and Water Quality, Land Use and Planning, Mineral Resources, Noise, Population and Housing, Public Services, Recreation, Transportation, Utilities and Service Systems, and Wildfire.
