

**NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A
MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION**

Notice is hereby given that the public agency named below has completed an Initial Study of the following described project at the following location: Southeast corner of U.S. Highway 395 and Dos Palmas Road APN No. 3096-381-01 & 3096-381-09

Project Description:	A Site Plan, Conditional Use Permits, and a Tentative Parcel Map with an Initial Study and a Mitigated Negative Declaration to allow for the development of a fueling station with alcohol sales and an accessory carwash, drive-thru restaurants, and a hotel, as well as the subdivision of two existing parcels into 6 parcels on properties zoned C-1 (Neighborhood Service) and R-1 (Single-family Residential) located at the southeast corner of U.S. Highway 395 and Dos Palmas Road
Project Location:	Southeast corner of U.S. Highway 395 and Dos Palmas Road; APN: 3096-381-01 & 3096-381-09; Within the City of Victorville, County of San Bernardino, State of California, San Bernardino Meridian, Section 27, Township 5N, Range 5W.

This Initial Study was completed in accordance with the Lead Agency's Guidelines for Implementing the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). This Initial Study was undertaken for the purpose of deciding whether the project may have a significant effect on the environment. On the basis of such Initial Study, the Lead Agency's Staff has concluded that the project will not have a significant effect on the environment, and has therefore prepared a Draft Mitigated Negative Declaration. The Initial Study reflects the independent judgment of the Lead Agency.
