Project Title: Argonaut Mine Stormwater Upgrade (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. AMA-41261-R2)

Project Location: The project is located at an unnamed tributary to Jackson Creek, in the County of Amador, State of California; Latitude 38.35347, Longitude -120.78012 (WGS 84 datum, decimal degrees); Assessor's Parcel Number 020-150-011, 020-150-010, 020-150-004, 020-150-012, 020-070-002, 020-070-041, 020-171-002, and 012-150-004.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number AMA-41261-R2), pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Department of Toxic Substances Control as Represented by Juan Peng.

The project includes infrastructure upgrades along Sutter Street with slightly larger diameter culverts, improved culvert inlets, new manholes, and additional drainage inlets.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above-described Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
