**Project Title:** Copper Creek Ranch Project  
(Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. PLU-32743-R2)  
(2-22EX-00747-PLU)

**Project Location:** The projects are located within the boundaries of timber harvesting activities in Plumas County, within CALWATER watersheds East Branch North Fork Feather River, Lower Wolf Creek, on Williams Creek and their connecting tributaries; Township 27N, Range 9E, Sections 26, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) Quad Map Greenville; Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

**Project Description:** The projects (2-22EX-000747-PLU) are limited to the temporary placement of two Spittler log crossings due to impacts from the Dixie Fire and is limited to the temporary placement and removal of the logs along Williams Creek, tributary to Wolf Creek on a Class I & II watercourses.
