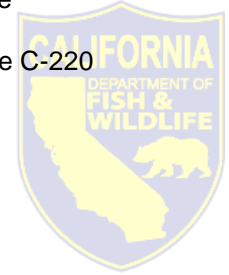

Project Title: TD1748177 Tenaja Road Deteriorated Pole Replacement Project

Project Location (include county): The Tenaja Road Deteriorated Pole Replacement project (project) is located near the intersection of Cleveland Forest Road and Tenaja Road within an unnamed stream (Exhibit 1) that is tributary to San Mateo Creek, in the County of Riverside, State of California; Latitude 33.505534, Longitude - 117.353709.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. EPIMS-RIV-30094-R6, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Southern California Edison (SCE). The project is limited to removing and replacing one wood pole (Pole 4357931E) with a composite pole and removing and installing two anchors in support of existing wood Pole 4357930E (Pole will not be replaced), and trimming of surrounding vegetation.

Project activities described above are anticipated to temporarily impact 0.021 acres (60 linear feet) of Fish and Game Code Section 1602 resources.
