Project Title: Salmon Creek Erosion Mitigation Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-SHA-31595-R1)

Project Location (include county): The proposed Project is located on Salmon Creek at T31N, 04W, Section 2 of the Enterprise 7.5-minute United States Geological Survey (USGS) quadrangle, Shasta County Assessor's Parcel Number (APN) 111-280-008-000, 9550 Twin Creek Lane in Redding.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-SHA-31595-R1, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Gregg Duralia.

Over the course of the past several years high instream flows have resulted in substantial erosion and undermining of vegetation along the east bank of Salmon Creek. The proposed Project includes installation of instream armoring structures and creation of a side channel for the purposes of erosion mitigation by reducing flow velocities along the bank edge. Stabilizing the bank will preserve the existing oak trees and provide areas for establishment of native willows.
