Project Title: Bohannon Dam Automation Project (Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. SUT-26013-R2)

Project Location: The project is located at an unnamed irrigation canal, tributary to the Sacramento River, in the County of Sutter, State of California; Latitude 33.886925, Longitude - 121.716090.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number SUT-26013-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Sutter Mutual Water Company.

The project consists of the installation of a Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) system and automation controls on the gates of the existing Bohannon Dam to allow more efficient operation of the irrigation system and a reduction in spills past the Bohannon Dam.
