Project Title: McClellan Business Park Stormwater Maintenance (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2017-0050-R2)

Project Location: The project is located within the boundaries of the McClellan Business Park in Sacramento County, covering natural and altered creeks and channels. The watercourses included within this Agreement are Don Julio Creek, Magpie Creek, and Robles Creek.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has extended Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2017-0050-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to MBP Ventures, LLC.

The project is limited to maintenance of stream channels within the McClellan Business Park. Activities may include debris and obstruction removal, silt, sand or sediment removal, vegetation control (including hand cutting, mowing, chain sawing), non-native vegetation removal, repair of previous erosion control work or new minor erosion control work.
