Allow expansion of an existing automobile service station which will include the addition of two gas pumps (four fueling positions), a 760 square-foot canopy, two 10,000-gallon above-ground storage tanks on a 2.32-acre parcel in the C-1 (Neighborhood Shopping Center) Zone District.

The project site is located on the northeast corner of Belmont and Temperance Avenues, approximately forty-eight feet northeast of the nearest city limits of the City of Fresno (7064 E. Belmont Ave) (APN: 310-143-46) (Sup. Dist. 5).
