Project Location (San Bernardino): The project is located at an unnamed tributary to the Oro Grande Wash, in the County of San Bernardino, State of California; Latitude 34.418427; Longitude -117.391883; or Section 22, Township 4 North, Range 5 West, San Bernardino Base and Meridian of the Baldy Mesa U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) map 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 3064-581-02-0000.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement (EPIMS-SBR-41604-R6), pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, to the project Applicant, CRP NC Hesperia Owner, LLC.

The Project is limited to development of a 408,997 square foot warehouse building, including: removing existing vegetation on site; grading and excavation of site soils to a depth of at least 7 feet below existing grade and to a depth of at least 3 feet below proposed pad grade and soils to be balanced on site; additional improvements including installation of sidewalks, utility connections, implementation of stormwater facilities, and pavement of parking areas and driveways; and landscaping.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on December 20, 2023 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

- 1. The project **will not** have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
