**Project Description**  
 Director’s Order requested funds on 3/24/2022 to repair a failed box culvert (#24 0029) at postmile 2.360 on State Route (SR) 99 in Sacramento County, initially reported as a settling fence on 3/21/2022. In response, it was discovered that the settling fence was due to the failed box culvert which transverses SR 99. Caltrans proposes to replace in-kind the 20-foot section of the top cement slab of the box culvert to maintain public right of way use and prevent an emergency resulting from the risk of a failed culvert under the roadway.
