Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number AMA-26171-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, John Hay.

The project involves the removal of a felled and decaying tree and the placement of clean, rock slope protection for approximately 80 feet of bank, extending between 10 to 15 feet up the exposed bank to prevent catastrophic bank failure.
