**Project Title:** Diablo Road Trail Project (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-CCA-30250-R3)

**Project Location (Contra Costa County):** The Project is located at Green Valley Creek, a tributary to East Branch Green Valley Creek, in the Town of Danville, County of Contra Costa, State of California; terminus (Latitude 37.835821, Longitude -121.971803) to terminus (Latitude 37.831682, Longitude -121.956150).

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement (EPIMS-CCA-30250-R3), pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, to the project Applicant, Town of Danville, as represented by Nader Salama.

The Project involves installation of a 0.9-mile Class I pedestrian/bicycle trail, bank stabilization of a section of East Branch Green Valley Creek, and installation of retaining walls. The Project will result in approximately 0.033 acres of permanent impacts to creek bed, bank, or channel and approximately 0.387 acres of permanent impacts to riparian woodland.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on February 14, 2025, and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project **will not** have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the **Mitigated Negative Declaration** prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures **were** made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan **was** adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations **was not** adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings **were not** made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
