**Project Location (include county):** The project is located at an unnamed, ephemeral tributary to Swede Creek in the County of Shasta, state of California; Latitude 40.585489, Longitude -122.221945; 10305 Swede Creek Road, Palo Cedro, 96073; Assessor's Parcel Number 061-390-24-00.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has issued to Timothy James Stover an executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement, EPIMS-SHA-33624-R1I, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code.

The project is limited to the installation of a new culverted stream crossing consisting of one 60-foot long,18-inch-diameter corrugated metal pipe (CMP). The CMP has been sized to convey 100-year stormflows (Exhibit A) and will be installed in accordance to engineered plans (Exhibit B). The new stream crossing will allow for driveway access to a proposed residence on the eastside of the parcel. A backhoe or mini excavator will be used to complete the project. Project activities will impact approximately 60 linear feet of bed, bank, and channel.
