Project Title: Swede Creek Tributary Culvert Installation (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement, EPIMS-SHA-33624-R11)

Project Location (include county): The project is located at an unnamed, ephemeral tributary to Swede Creek in the County of Shasta, state of California; Latitude 40.585489, Longitude -122.221945; 10305 Swede Creek Road, Palo Cedro, 96073; Assessor's Parcel Number 061-390-24-00.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has issued to Timothy James Stover an executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement, EPIMS-SHA-33624-R11, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code.

The project is limited to the installation of a new culverted stream crossing consisting of one 60-foot long, 18-inch-diameter corrugated metal pipe (CMP). The CMP has been sized to convey 100-year stormflows (Exhibit A) and will be installed in accordance to engineered plans (Exhibit B). The new stream crossing will allow for driveway access to a proposed residence on the eastside of the parcel. A backhoe or mini excavator will be used to complete the project. Project activities will impact approximately 60 linear feet of bed, bank, and channel.


Exempt Status:

Statutory Exemption.

Categorical Exemption. Type – **Class 4; California Code of Regulations, title 14, section 15304**, Minor public or private alterations in the condition of land, water, and/or vegetation which do not involve removal of healthy, mature, scenic trees except for forestry and agricultural purposes.

Reasons why project is exempt: The project is limited to 60 linear feet of ephemeral drainage impacts on private land. No trees will be removed over the course of authorized project activities.
