



NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION AND NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF AN INITIAL STUDY WITH PROPOSED MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR THE STATE ROUTE 12 MAJOR PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROJECT

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), the Lead Agency for the California Environmental Quality Act, is issuing a Notice of Availability of the Initial Study with Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) for public and agency review and a Notice of Intent to adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration.

WHAT IS BEING PLANNED?

The proposed Project is located on State Route (SR) 12 from Post Mile (PM) 7.77 to PM 14.1 in Solano County. The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) proposes to resurface the existing pavement on both mainline traveled ways and shoulders, replace existing K-rails located in the median with concrete barriers, replace rumble strips along the shoulder and centerline, replace existing metal beam guardrails (MBGR) with Midwest guardrail system (MGS), upgrade the existing crash cushions to current standards, and repair damaged drainage systems. The existing shoulders within the Project limits would be widened to 8 feet and the existing asphalt concrete dikes would be relocated to the edge of pavement to accommodate the 8-foot shoulders.

WHY THIS AD?

Caltrans has studied the proposed project and has determined that with mitigation incorporated, there would not be any significant impacts to environmental resources as a result of the project. The Draft IS/MND explains why the project would, with mitigation, not have significant impacts to environmental resources. This public notice is to inform you that the Draft IS/MND is available for review during the 30-day public comment period.
