Proposed repair includes slope stabilization and vegetation clearance. Proposed upgrades and replacements include wrought iron fencing installation in existing fenced areas, hardscape placement, and gore paving. The proposed work is needed to prevent unauthorized entry into Caltrans right-of-way and prevent further damage and possible infrastructure failure of existing facilities.
