PROJECT TITLE: Anderson Ranch House Rehabilitation

LOCATION: Anderson Marsh State Historic Park **COUNTY:** Lake

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Project proposes to complete stabilization, repair and rehabilitation work on three (3) small outbuildings and the main house at Anderson Marsh State Historic Park to allow continued use of the buildings for interpretive purposes. Work will:

- To stabilize the three (3) existing small outbuildings:
 - Use hand tools to correct racking in the walls to bring the buildings relatively plumb; and
 - Install new interior reinforcing to help stabilize the straightened walls.
- To repaint the west elevation above the porch on the main house:
 - Test for the presence of lead and remediate properly if needed;
 - Scrape to remove failed paint; and
 - Apply one (1) coat of primer and two (2) coats of exterior paint, colored to match existing.
- To rehabilitate the main house windows:
 - Treat the wood sashes with linseed oil, and apply primer and paint to match existing;
 - Replace damaged glass panes as needed; and
 - Replace any broken sash cords and make windows operable.
