Continued from page 1:

The proposed project would include the following avoidance and minimization measures:

- Standard Special Provision 36-4 Lead Compliance Plan will be included in the Plans, Specifications, and Estimate package.
- If yellow striping will be removed separately, SSP 14-11.12 is required for proper management of hazardous waste residue and a lead compliance plan will need to be prepared. Include SSP 36-4 and/or 84-9.03B for work involving residue from grinding and cold planing that contains lead from paint and thermoplastic and addresses the need for a Lead Compliance Plan (note that one Lead Compliance Plan may address soil and paint/marketing materials).
- NSSP 14-11.14 Treated Wood Waste will be required to address handling and disposal of any potential wood waste generated during the project (guardrail segments, signposts, etc.). Please note that treated wood waste must be disposed of as a hazardous material at a California disposal site operating under a Department of Toxic Substance Control permit (Class I landfill).
