DESCRIPTION OF PREVIOUS ACTION: The City of San Diego previously prepared a Mitigated Negative Declaration for the Citywide Pipelines project (Project No. 255100). The Mitigated Negative Declaration was certified by the City of San Diego City Council on November 30, 2011, Resolution No. 30712.

DESCRIPTION OF SUBSEQUENT ACTION: City of San Diego Development Services Department approval of Addendum to Mitigated Negative Declaration No. 255100 in association with a Public Project Assessment for the Sewer and Water Group 793A Project.

PROJECT LOCATION: The project is located within the Southeastern San Diego Planning Area. Surrounding land uses include existing residential, institutional, and commercial developments. The project would occur within developed public rights-of-way and public utility easements located within previously disturbed private property.

The project would generally be located within the following streets: 19th Street between G Street and Island Avenue; 20th Street between G Street and J Street; 21st Street between G Street and K Street; 22nd Street between G Street and Market Street, and J Street to K Street; 24th Street between G Street and L Street; 25th Street between J Street and L Street; G Street between 22nd Street and 24th Street; an unnamed alley between G Street and Market Street from 24th Street to 25th Street; Market Street between 19th Street and 20th Street, and 22nd Street and 24th Street; an unnamed alley between Market Street and Island Avenue from 24th Street and 25th Street; an unnamed alley between Island Avenue and J Street from 24th Street to 25th Street; an unnamed alley between J Street and K Street from 24th Street to 25th Street; K Street from 22nd Street to an unnamed alley between 25th Street and 26th Street; and an unnamed alley between K Street and L Street from 24th Street to 25th Street.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Sewer and Water Group 793A project is part of the City's on-going Sewer Main and Water Main Replacement Program. The existing sewer and water mains are old and are nearing the end of their service life. Construction of the project would reduce maintenance requirements, correct hydraulic deficiencies, improve reliability and accessibility, and bring the sewer and water main systems up to current design standards.

The project proposes the abandonment of 297 linear feet of sewer main and the replacement of 12,303 linear feet of existing 6-inch and 8-inch vitrified clay (VC) and concrete pipe (CP) sewer mains with 8-inch and 10-inch polyvinyl chloride (PVC) sewer mains. Additionally, 323 sewer laterals would be reconnected to the new sewer pipelines, two of which are located on private property. The project also includes the replacement of 5,300 linear feet of 8-inch asbestos cement (AC) water mains with 6-inch, 8-inch and 12-inch PVC water mains. Additionally, 71 water services would be reconnected to the new water pipelines and 10 fire hydrants and 5 fire services would be replaced. The project would also include the installation of 14 new manholes, curb ramps, alley aprons and cross gutters, laterals, cleanouts, water services, slurry seal, street resurfacing and striping. The project would also remove two street trees to accommodate the curb ramps.

Trenches would be approximately three feet in width and would not exceed 15 feet in depth. Construction methods would include open trenching, tunneling, and pipeline abandonment. During the construction phase of the project, it is estimated that work hours would be between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. The contractor would comply with the requirements in the Standard Specifications for Public Works Construction. Construction materials would be stored in the related streets and alleys as the work progresses.

The project would comply with the requirements described in the Standard Specifications for Public Works Construction, and California Department of Transportation's Manual of Traffic Controls for Construction and Maintenance Work Zones. A traffic control plan would be prepared and implemented in accordance with the City of San Diego Standard Drawings Manual of Traffic Control for Construction and Maintenance Work Zones. Best Management Practices would be required and specified within the approved Water Pollution Control Plan for erosion control and storm drain inlet protection.

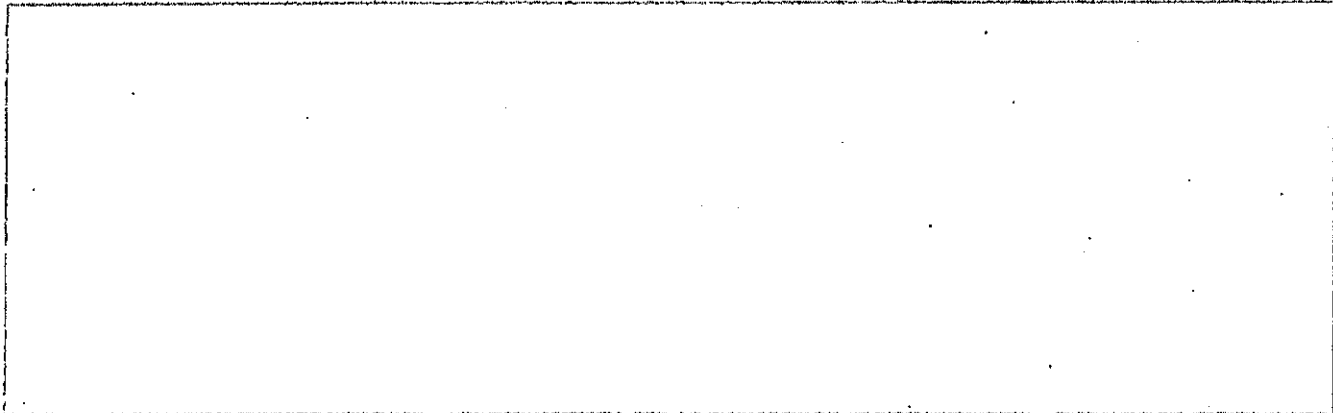
