Project Location/Address/City/County: The project is located approximately 1.6 miles northeast of the community of Butte City, within Area E of the Butte Basin, in Glenn County.

Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project: To authorize the following existing encroachments: An 87 foot long, 50 foot wide, and 14-foot-high barn with roof mounted solar modifications; a 37 foot long, 30 foot wide, and 21 foot high shed; a 39 foot long, 35 foot wide, and 18 foot high shed; all located on an agricultural parcel within the Butte Basin.
