Project Title: Stenner Creek Watershed Enhancement Project
(Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-SLO-36662-R4)

Project Location: The Project will occur within two streams, Stenner Creek and Brizziolari Creek, and their unnamed tributaries, located within the City of San Luis Obispo, San Luis Obispo County, California; Section 00, Township 30 South, Range 12 East; U.S. Geological Survey Map San Luis Obispo; Assessor's Parcel Numbers 073-291-002, 073-301-003, and 073-311-001.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement Number EPIMS-SLO-36662-R4 pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602 for the Coastal San Luis Resource Conservation District's Stenner Creek Watershed Enhancement Project (Project). The Project includes activities related to the alteration or replacement of 22 stream crossings within Stenner Creek, Brizziolari Creek, and tributaries (streams). The Project will improve slope stability, reduce erosion, prevent future sediment delivery, promote riparian revegetation, and improve ecological watershed function.
