The City of Salinas (City) is proposing to implement improvements to its industrial wastewater treatment system (proposed project), which treats wastewater from local agriculture-based industries to provide operational and efficiency improvements as well as capacity reliability and redundancy enhancements for the industrial users. Environmental impacts of this project have been analyzed in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and a Draft Initial Study and Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) have been prepared for the project. Based on the environmental document, the project will not have a significant effect on the environment.
