DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

The Project is to replace the existing modular (mobile home) at the Well's Fargo location at Salt Point State Park with a new modular to provide upgraded, safe housing for park staff. Work will remove the existing modular and install the new modular on the same site, in the same footprint, as the removed modular, excavate to install a new power pole and string new wires to re-activate the electrical power supply.
