Project Title: Cannabis remediation and habitat restoration at APN 580-040-003 (Notification of Lake or Streambed Alteration, No. EPIMS-RIV-30683-R6)

Project Location (Riverside County): The project is located at 49250 Silent Valley Road in the City of Aguanga within Riverside County in the State of California; Latitude 33.44557 N, Longitude -116.80045 W; Assessor's Parcel Number (APN) 580-040-003.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. EPIMS-RIV-30683-R6, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Peter Cho.

The project is limited to the remediation of unpermitted cannabis cultivation and habitat restoration at APN 580-040-003. The project includes the removal an unpermitted dam, disposal of various debris, revegetation, and general restoration activities.
