**Project Title:** Euer Valley Restoration Project – Phase 1 (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. NEV-32483-R2)

**Project Location:** The project is located at South Fork Prosser Creek in Euer Valley, a tributary of the Truckee River, in the County of Nevada, State of California; Latitude 39.36882, Longitude -120.28699; Assessor’s Parcel Number 016-060-024-000. The Project area is roughly 30 acres at approximately 6,500 feet in elevation, 11 miles northwest of the Town of Truckee and is accessible via Alder Creek and Euer Valley Roads.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. NEV-32483-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Truckee River Watershed Council as represented by Eben Swain.

The project is limited to installation of a bridge and elevated meadow boardwalk; stabilization of an equestrian crossing; improvements to an earthen trail and South Euer Valley Road; and in-water stabilization measures in approximately ½ mile of South Fork Prosser Creek.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above Streambed Alteration Agreement for the project on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW’s permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the  mitigated negative declaration /  negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures  were /  were not made a condition of CDFW’s approval of the project.
