As lead agency under the California Environmental Quality Act, the Port of Stockton is providing this Notice of Intent to adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) and Supplemental Environmental Assessment (EA) to the 1980 San Francisco Bay to Stockton Environmental Impact Statement – Supplement III assessing the potential environmental effects associated with the following project:

Port of Stockton McDonald Island Dredged Material Placement Site Project

The proposed project is located on McDonald Island in San Joaquin County, California.

The proposed project involves the construction of a new 18-acre placement site on McDonald Island for dredged material resulting from maintenance dredging activities conducted by the U.S Army Corps of Engineers in the Stockton Deepwater Ship Channel.
