Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

The project is extending water and sewer service to Alpine Court, a farm labor camp on a single parcel. The project consists of the abandonment of existing septic tanks and sanitary sewer, and construction of a new sewer collection system, lift station, municipal fire service and hydrant, and potable water service with a master meter. The project would cap and abandon the two on-site wells. The new water and sewer lines will connect to city water and sewer pipelines located in Gonzales River Road.
