Project Location/City/County: The project is located near the right (north) bank of the Yuba River beginning at the North Training Wall Phase 1 northern terminus and extending upstream 1,040 feet to high ground approximately 2,500 feet downstream of the Daguerre Point Dam, in Yuba County.

Project Description: Approval of Permit No. 19734, under California Code of Regulations, Title 23, Article 3, Section 6, for work within an adopted plan of flood control: To construct the Yuba River North Training Wall Project - Phase 2 (High Ground Tie-In) consisting of 1,040 feet of new levee embankment with a patrol road, new access roads and ramps, test pits for geotechnical data collection, replacement of the Hallwood-Cordua Canal culvert, and staging areas.

This is to advise that the Board, as the **Responsible Agency**, approved the above-described project on September 27, 2024 and made the following determinations regarding the above-described project:
