Project Title: Road D112 Bates Slough Bridge (No. 46C-0013) Replacement Project

Project Location - Specific: The project is located at the southwest boundary of the City of Tulare, approximately 0.07 miles south of Avenue 196 and 0.28 miles west of State Route 99.

Project Location- Section, Township, Range: Section 35, Township 20 S, Range 24 E, MDBM

Project Location - City: Tulare Project Location - County: Tulare

Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project: Tulare County (County) proposes to replace the existing Road D112 Bridge (Bridge 46C-0013) over Bates Slough/Elk Bayou Ditch. The project includes replacement of the existing bridge in-kind (similar bridge type and location). The proposed bridge structure consists of 31-foot long, 2-cell grade-top box culvert with 14-foot wide openings, and will accommodate a 12-foot lane and 4-foot shoulder in each direction. In addition, the project includes improvements on the approach roadways extending approximately 400 feet to the south and 400 feet to the north of the existing bridge. Sliver widening is proposed on Road D112, north of the existing approach roadway and terminating at the intersection with Avenue 196. The sliver widening would be necessary to avoid an irregular project tie-in between the bridge and Avenue 196.
