The Project is located approximately 3 miles north of the unincorporated community of Trona, California on Assessor parcels 038-330-46.  
The applicant is applying for a Renewable Energy Permit to construct a 1.2 milliwatt (mW) photovoltaic solar facility using approximately 2,300 fixed tilt or single-axis tracker solar panels. The project site is on one 5-acre parcel that is highly disturbed with no natural vegetation or structures on the site. The project is also devoid of natural habitat and the parcel has previously been graded.
