Project Title: San Miguel Drive Culvert Rehabilitation Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-CCA-20450-R3)

Project Location: The project is located at San Ramon Creek, tributary to Walnut Creek, in the County of Contra Costa, State of California; Latitude 37.881782, Longitude -122.036535.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement number CCA-20450-R3, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Contra Costa County Public Works Department, as represented by Allison Knapp.

The project will replace-in-kind a 72-inch diameter, 47-foot-long corrugated metal pipe (CMP) culvert and reconstruct portions of the roadway above the culvert. The invert of the pipe will be lined with approximately five cubic yards of concrete reinforced with one layer (approximately 885 square feet) of 10-gage, 6-inch by 6-inch steel mesh. After the concrete has cured, the road shoulder above the south end of the pipe will be reconstructed.
