Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project:

The Sierra Nevada Conservancy would provide funding for the Sierra County Land Trust (SCLT) to acquire 168+/- acres of private property, including mineral rights. The property consists of vacant red fir complex forested site at 7300-7900ft surrounded by USFS lands in the Tahoe and Plumas national forests. The project goal is to ensure use of the property for public open space and recreation, while ensuring the protection and long-term management of this high-elevation upper watershed site with its forest, water, wildlife, recreation, and scenic resources.
