### Informe Final de Impacto Ambiental/Evaluación Ambiental (FONSI)



Caltrans ha publicado el Informe Final de Impacto Ambiental/Evaluación Ambiental (EIR/EA) con una Determinación de No Impacto Significativo (FONSI) para el Proyecto de Reapertura de la Ruta Estatal (SR) 39 (San Gabriel Canyon Road). Caltrans ha evaluado la posibilidad de rehabilitar y reabrir un segmento de 4.4 millas de la SR-39, desde la milla 40.0 hasta la 44.4, dentro del Bosque Nacional Ángeles, en el Condado de Los Ángeles. Después de evaluar los efectos ambientales, se ha seleccionado la Alternativa 2, Ruta de Evacuación (Construcción Mínima), como la alternativa preferida. Esta opción se centra en una restauración limitada de la carretera para cumplir con los estándares esenciales de seguridad. Esta ruta estaría restringida para el uso de los servicios de emergencia, personal de mantenimiento o como ruta de evacuación durante emergencias o desastres naturales. Este aviso es para informarle que el Informe Final de Impacto Ambiental / Evaluación Ambiental (EIR/EA) y la Determinación de No Impacto Significativo (FONSI) para el proyecto propuesto han sido aprobados y están disponibles para el público.
