**Title:** Issuance of a General Lease – Recreational Use – Lease 6609

**Location:** Sovereign land in Lake Tahoe, adjacent to 5850 North Lake Boulevard, near Carnelian Bay, Placer County.

**Description:** Authorize issuance of a General Lease – Recreational Use beginning December 24, 2022, for a term of 10 years, for the use and maintenance of a pier, two unattached pilings, and two mooring buoys.
