The project occurred along State Route (SR) 89, from post mile (PM) 14.9 to 17.3, in Alpine County.

Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:
Caltrans completed emergency repairs in response to an extreme storm event that occurred on 8/3/22. The storm caused severe damages to the roadway, roadside ditches, and drainage facilities. The culvert at PM 15.21 washed downstream, leaving the roadway unsafe for travel. The scope of work included installing a temporary creek crossing, clearing debris and sediment, reestablishing drainage ditches, pavement repairs, placing shoulder backing, placing Rock Slope Protection, and replacing culverts and headwalls. The purpose of this project is to immediately rectify structural and drainage damages, and to reopen SR-89 to the traveling public. The project is needed to prevent the loss or impairment of life, property, or essential public services.
