Notice of Intent to Approve a Remedial Action Plan and Mitigated Negative Declaration

Former Univar/VWR Parcel B 3775 Bayshore Blvd. Brisbane, San Mateo County GeoTracker ID# T10000005054 January 10, 2023

The San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) regulates this site for the investigation and cleanup of volatile organic compounds, petroleum hydrocarbons, and 1,4-dioxane historically released from a former chemical storage aboveground tank farm. EHS Support has prepared a Remedial Action Plan on behalf of VWR/Univar, proposing thermal conductive heating as the remedy for treating impacted groundwater and soil at the site to a depth of 55 feet below the ground surface. The remedy was evaluated in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act, and an Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration was prepared. No significant effects were identified, and it was determined that the project will have a Less Than Significant Impact with Mitigation Incorporated.

A notice was sent to all interested parties within one mile of the site, and other stakeholders on October 31, 2022. A 60-day public comment period ended January 6, 2023, and several comments were received. A public meeting was also held on November 15, 2022, by Regional Water Board staff and the Responsible Party.
