Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

The San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA) proposes to establish a citywide Slow Streets Program for selected streets to create a network of residential streets that would prioritize biking, walking, and other forms of active transportation by enhancing the safety and protection of persons who use these Slow Streets. The Slow Streets Program team would conduct a design and public hearing process to determine specific design treatments that would limit traffic volumes and speeds on each Slow Street corridor and allow the corridors to be safely used by people traveling by foot, bicycle, and other forms of active transportation. The SFMTA has defined a Slow Streets Toolkit of design treatments to achieve the desired traffic volumes and speeds.
