Project Title: 7340 28th Street Grading Permit (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. SAC-39648-R2)

Project Location: The project is located at an unnamed tributary to Dry Creek, in the County of Sacramento, State of California; Latitude 38.700192, Longitude -121.400494 (WGS 84 datum, decimal degrees) 7340 28th Street, Rio Linda, CA, 95673; Assessor's Parcel Number [208-0071-008-0000].

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. SAC-39648-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Pulltail Inc.

The project is limited to the construction of a truck trailer storage facility. The project site encompasses 9.8 acres, and the entire parcel will be graded. The amount of material cut is estimated at 10,653 cubic yards with an estimated amount to be filled of 10,546 cubic yards. Grading will be accomplished using a backhoe and grader. Water trucks will spray water on all exposed soil onsite twice a day to prevent dust during construction activities. All work will be completed during the dry season. Several trees with a greater than four (4) inch diameter at breast height (dbh) will be removed.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above-described Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were / were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
