Project Title: CalVTP Northern California Veterans Cemetery Project

Project Location: Northern California Veterans Cemetery, Igo, Shasta County

Project Description: The Western Shasta Resource Conservation District (WSRCD) proposes to implement vegetation treatments and maintenance treatments on 100 acres of land for the CalVTP Northern California Veterans Cemetery Project (Project) in Shasta County. WSRCD has prepared a Project-Specific Analysis (PSA) to evaluate if the project is within the scope of the Program EIR for the California Vegetation Treatment Program (CalVTP) and provide environmental information to WSRCD. Project implementation will include manual treatments in conjunction with a chipper and/or pile and burning, mechanical treatments, and prescribed burning. The CalVTP Northern California Veterans Cemetery Project PSA was prepared for the project as a later activity covered by the CalVTP Program EIR.

This Notice of Determination is to advise that WSRCD

(Lead Agency or Responsible Agency) has approved the above-described project on January 25, 2023 and has made the following determinations related to the PSA:

1. The Project will have a potentially significant effect on the environment.
2. The CalVTP Northern California Veterans Cemetery Project PSA (SCH# _____) was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
3. The CalVTP Program EIR sufficiently analyzes and addresses potential environmental impacts from the project, and the project will not trigger any of the criteria requiring additional CEQA review pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15162. The project will not result in new significant impacts or a substantial increase in the severity of the significant environmental impacts identified in the CalVTP Program EIR. The proposed project is within the scope of the CalVTP Program EIR consistent with CEQA Guidelines Section 15168(c)(2), as documented in the PSA.
4. Mitigation measures and standard project requirements from the CalVTP Program EIR were made a condition of the approval of the project; no new project-specific mitigation measures are required.
5. The implementation of applicable CalVTP Program EIR mitigation measures and standard project requirements will be monitored and reported pursuant to the Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program that was adopted for this project.


