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NOTICE OF INTENT  
TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION  
GROUNDWATER PFAS TREATMENT FACILITY  
IN THE CITY OF FREMONT

Pursuant to the State of California Public Resources Code and the “Guidelines for Implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970” as amended to date, this is to advise you that the Alameda County Water District (ACWD) has prepared a Draft Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) for the Groundwater PFAS Treatment Facility (Project). The project is located at 1111 Mowry Ave, in the City of Fremont, Alameda County, California.

ACWD proposes construction of an Ion Exchange (IX) treatment facility to treat groundwater for regulated PFAS compounds. The facility will include installation of new piping, pumps, cartridge filters, IX pressure vessels, and associated civil site improvements. It will be constructed on ACWD property next to the existing Blending Facility.
