Project Title: Santa Margarita 58 CAPM Project (Notification No. EPIMS-SLO-47299-R4)

Project Location: The Project is located between highway postmile (PM) 1.77 and PM 6.86 on State Route (SR) 58, near the community of Santa Margarita, in San Luis Obispo County, California.

Project Description: The Project includes four culvert replacements, channel rerouting, headwall construction, concrete lining replacement, rock slope protection (RSP) installation, and restoring disturbed areas with seeding and plantings. This Project is part of a larger roadway rehabilitation and asset management project along SR 58 between PMs 1.8 and 6.9 in San Luis Obispo County.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on 6/19/2024, and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the Mitigated Negative Declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan was adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
